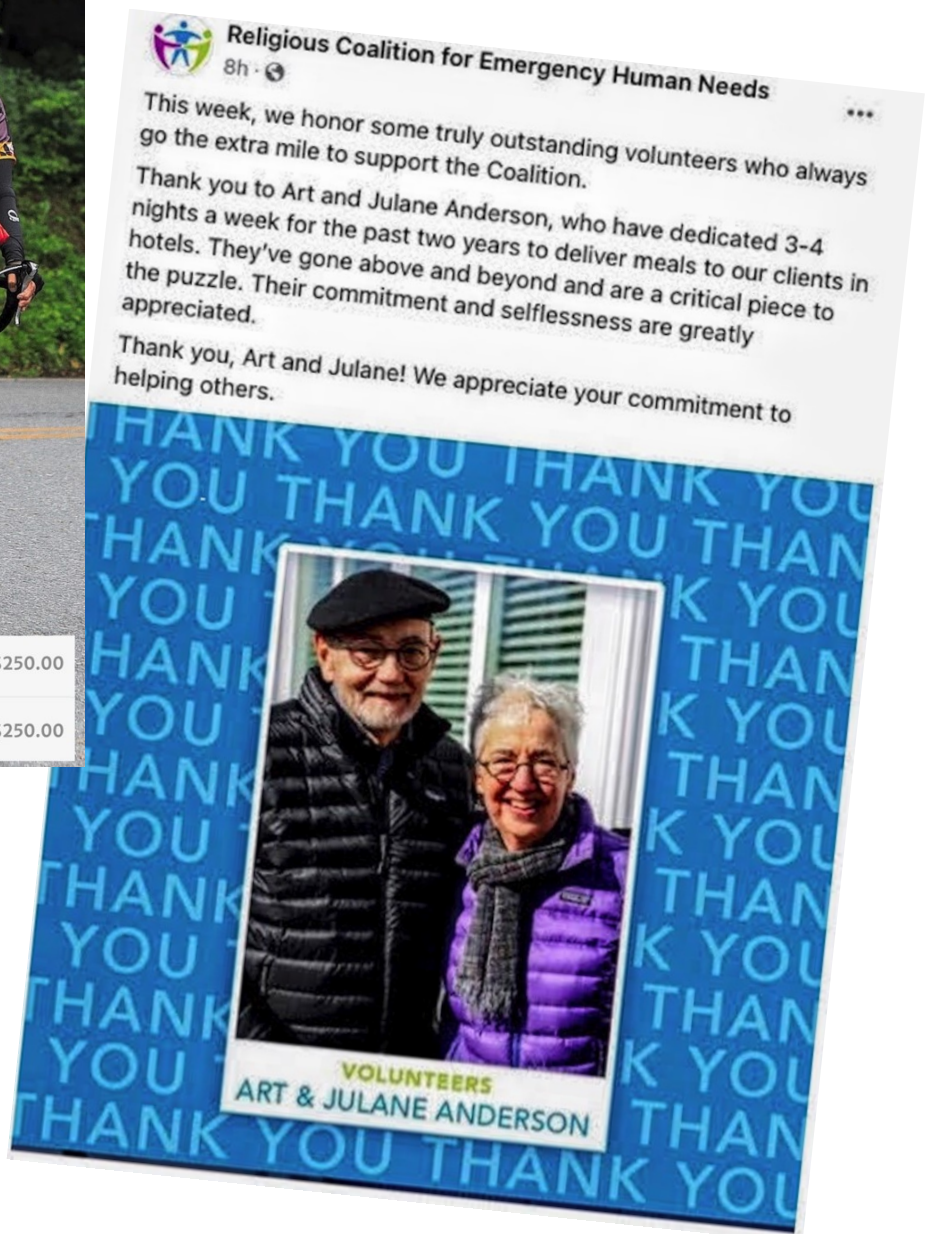

Eric Stephens was the speaker at the August 23, 2022 meeting of Kiwanis Club of Frederick. We met Eric last year when his son spoke to the club about his charitable project collecting contributions and donations of blankets pillows and bedding in support of the 501(c)(3) Bed Building Charity, Sleep in Heavenly Peace. Today, Eric is here to tell us about his 501(c)(3) i9 Sports of Frederick and Carroll Counties, which is a Franchise of i9 Sports Association, Inc. supporting Youth Sports Leagues and Programs which are independent of public school programs. The intent of i9 Sports is to help level the playing field so that all eligible children can gain sports experiences regardless of

their ability to pay for equipment, uniforms and related fees. Eric was excited about his upcoming fundraiser. It is a Family Fun community fundraiser basketball game involving the World Famous Harlem Wizards (A multitalented and entertaining Basketball Team fashioned after the Harlem Globetrotters) vs Team Frederick. Eric has already received commitments from Frederick School Principals, Coaches, Athletes and Dignitaries, including Jason Lando (Chief of Police). The Frederick Team Roster includes: Aje Hill (Founder of I Believe in Me), Aaron Vetter (Founder of City Youth Matrix), Timika Thrasher (CEO of the Boys and Girls Club), Josh Funk (CEO of Rehab 2 Perform), Danny Ferrar (CEO of Soldierfit), Brandon Chapman (Frederick Housing Authority mentor/88 Visual), Shana Knight (OED and Soul Street), Tiana Massaquoi (Girls on the Run), Evan Bates (YMCA), Kiwanian Jeremy Poling (NFM Lending), Scott Marceron (Owner of Let There Be Rock School) and several others. The new FCPS Superintendent (Cheryl Dyson) is aware of the event and has committed to being in attendance for the show. The Game will be Saturday November 12th from 6-8 PM at the Frederick Community College Basketball Gymnasium. Although most of us know it by heart and say it automatically when we are called upon to say it according to official duties to honor the flag, our country or a fallen comrade. But, how many of us recognize that the pledge wasn't always spoken. According to Richard, a pledge was first proposed in 1885. It went through various re-writes and was taken up by various proponents until 1954 when President Eisenhower and congress made the present pledge supported by Federal Law. God was mentioned and not mentioned in various versions of the pledge and the phrase "under God" became a permanent part of the pledge also in 1954. 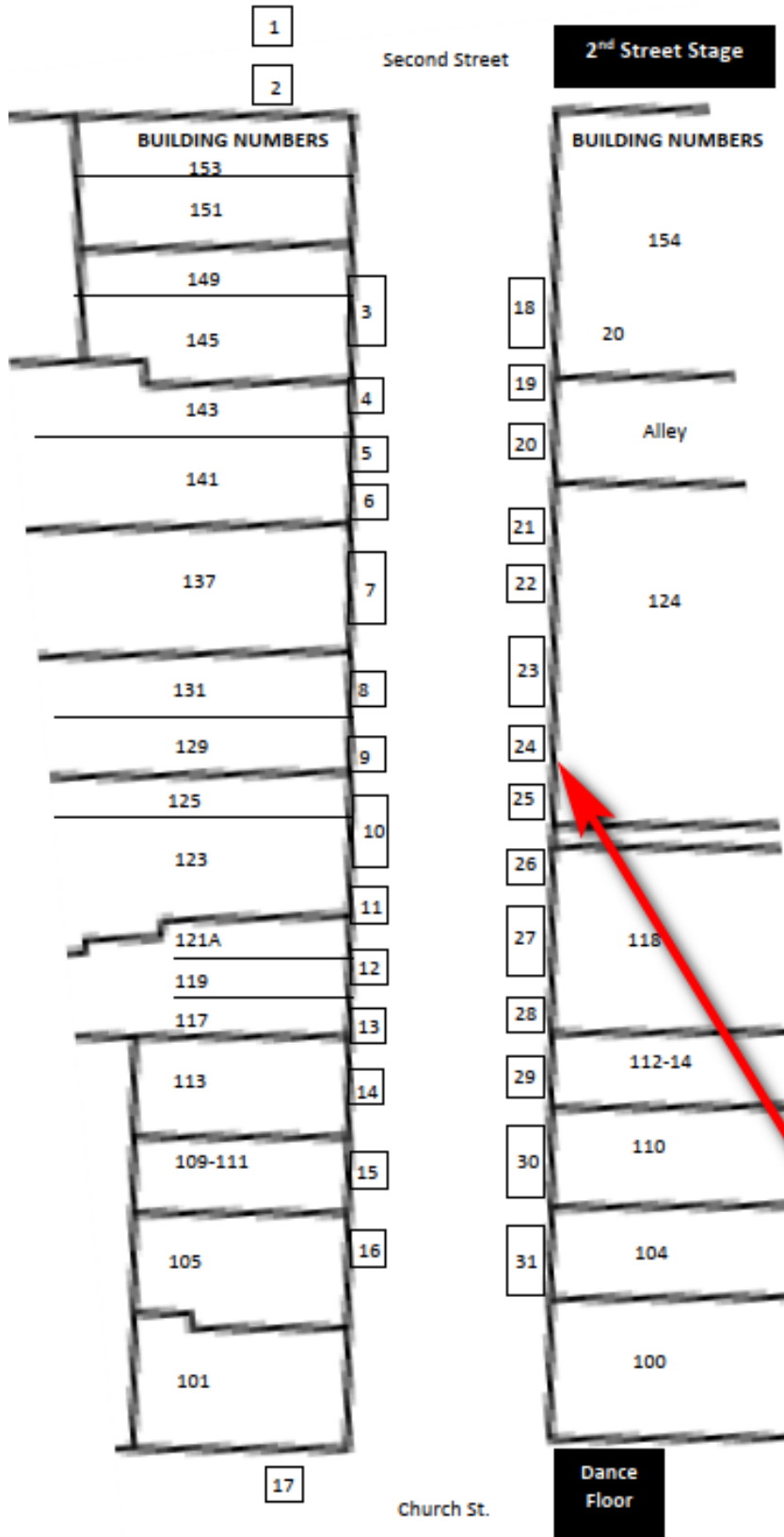
In The Streets is fast approaching! The event officially begins at 11 AM on Saturday, September 10th and ends at 5:00 PM.

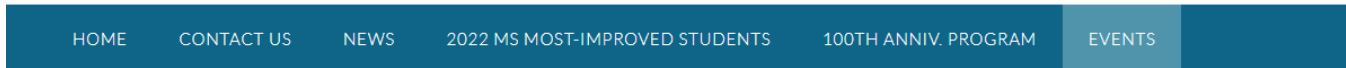
