At the bottom of the page will be Kiwanis Club of Frederick with a sponsor button. (Note: For Mt Olivet, at the bottom are multiple groups, Kiwanis Club of Frederick is on page 2.)

When you click the sponsor button, you will be taken to another Kiwanis page with an order sponsor button under the photo of the gravestones and wreaths. Click that sponsor button and you can follow the order form that appears.

Remember, by using the Kiwanis of Frederick group number, we get \$5 of each \$15 back!

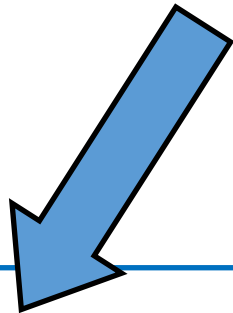
