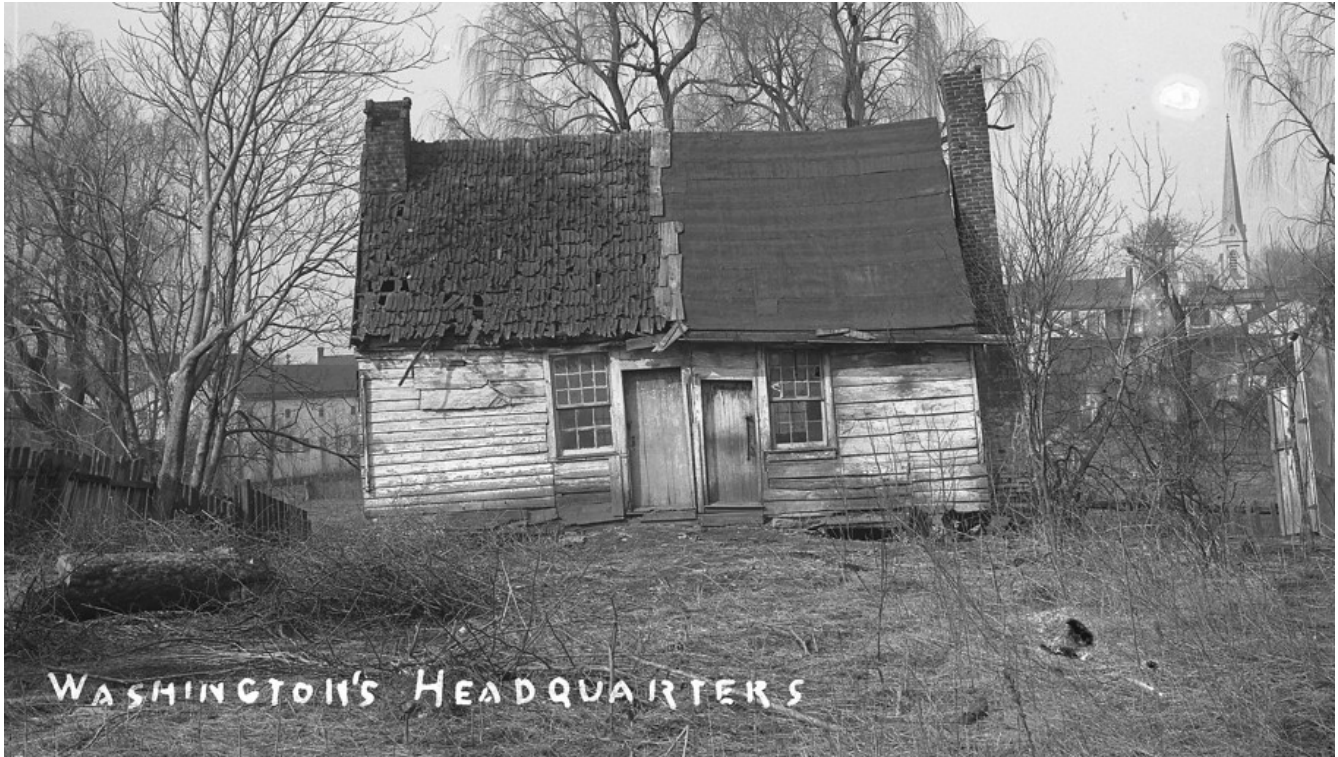

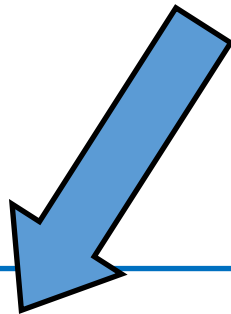

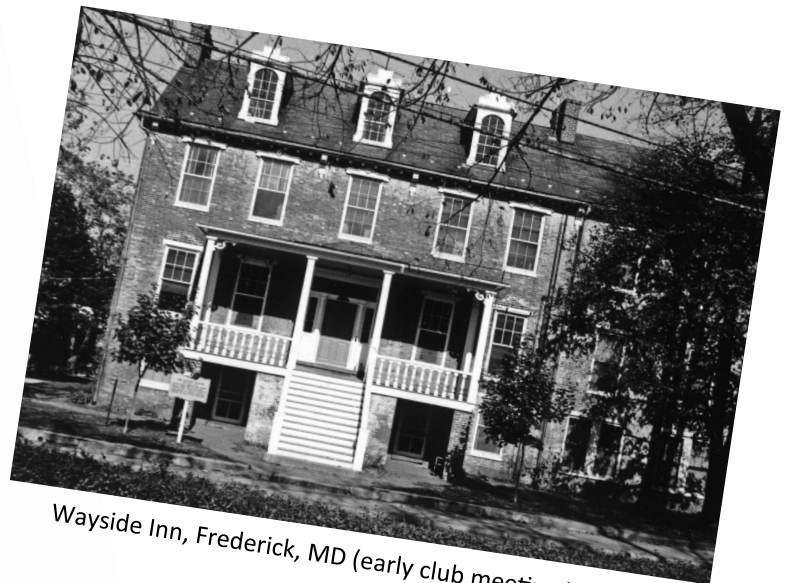

100 Years Ago
Oct. 11, 1922

Carrying out the policy of the International organization, the local Kiwanis Club devoted yesterday's luncheon meeting at Wayside Inn to the farmer and his problems. County Agent John McGill was the speaker. After explaining the difficulties that the farmers face at the present time, he called upon the members to give their moral support to the efforts that are being put forth by the farmers themselves to better their own conditions. On account of the low prices of farm products and the high cost of everything that he must buy, the farmer is about as hard hit as is any time in the history of agriculture.
