often sees them seeking through her law practice and that she would have loved to have when raising her children.

Currently, the Parent Resource Center is collaborating with the Frederick Keys to hold a sensory friendly game on July 22nd.

One of the stadium suites will be transformed into a sensory room, where there will be early entry, lower volume on music and announcements, and a special time and area set aside for pictures with the mascot.
